## Winter Mini Reading Challenge!

This year The Reading Agency teamed up with the Science Museum Group for the Gadgeteers Summer Reading Challenge - now the Gadgeteers are back for the Winter Mini Challenge!

The challenge runs **Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> December 2022 to Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2023**, and more information can be found by visiting <https://summerreadingchallenge.org.uk/>.

### How to take part

It's totally free to take part, and children need to register for the Winter Mini Challenge on the website, as the Challenge is online!

Children then choose a reading goal (recommended challenge is at least 3 books), and to complete the challenge, they need to read, rate and review their books on the website before the end of the challenge – they can choose any books, eBooks or audiobooks they like.

Rewards will be unlocked as they add their reviews, including a limited-edition virtual badge and a special Winter Mini Challenge certificate they can print out and keep!
