#### **Class News**

- Year F In Foundation this week we have started learning about the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears and are enjoying re-enacting the story and practicing our retelling skills through play. In PE we have been practicing throwing and catching balls, and in maths we have enjoyed playing '6 or not 6' and recapping our knowledge of doubles and evens, including representing these on a ten-frame. We loved dressing up for our Coronation celebration day, and took part in a procession with KS1 to show off our new designs for 'The Kings Pants' based on the story by Nicholas Allan.
- **Year 1** This week in Year 1 we have been learning how to add equal groups together in maths. We enjoyed celebrating the King's Coronation, decorating pants for the king! We are looking forward to our trip to the castle on Friday.
- **Year 2** Year 2 have been enjoying the coronation celebrations this week. We have been very busy learning our 2, 5 and 10 times tables in maths. In geography we learnt some features of a jungle.
- Year 3 We have had an exciting week this week! In English we have planned our adventure fantasy story based on the book Journey by Aaron Becker. We will be ready to write next week. In maths we have learnt to add and subtract money. We have had great fun with our art this week in developing a replicate of a Claude Monet painting. We have used mixed media to build our picture.

- Year 4 This week Year 4 have enjoyed time out in the sun. We explored the field during a science lesson to find insects to sketch and then add to an invertebrate classification diagram. We identified the features of a persuasive letter during English lessons. The class will be writing to the government, persuading them to help protect endangered animals and their habitats. Lastly this week we have made links between fractions and decimals and how to identify them using a number line.
- **Year 5** Year 5 have been working hard this week looking at how we can use fascinating facts and different sentence structures to engage the reader with our writing in English. In maths we completed our fractions assessment well done Year 5. We have also enjoyed learning all about the Kings Coronation on Thursday.
- Year 6 Year 6 have been really busy this week doing some last-minute preparations for SATs! We have been learning all about co-ordinates in maths and how to translate shapes on a co-ordinates grid. In English we have been revising different types of punctuation and how to use these in sentences. We are really enjoying our new guided reading book 'Clockwork' and are really intrigued about how it is going to end. We had a great time celebrating Stockham's Coronation Day, making art work in the style of Chuck Close and joining up with the rest of Key Stage 2 for a Coronation themed scavenger hunt.
