Class News

- Year F In Foundation this week we have been focused on pirates! A life on the seas sounds good to the Foundation crew and we have had a lot of fun with our focus story 'The Night Pirates'; creating our own pirates and thinking about what other adventures they might go on. We've used our collaborative building and painting efforts to create pirate ship role play areas both inside and outside, which has been lots of fun. We've also enjoyed a visit from Crocodiles of the World and made lots of links to the story of Captain Hook!
- Year 1 This week in Year 1 we enjoyed our visit from the Crocodiles of the World, where we saw a bearded dragon, snake, and crocodile. We have enjoyed learning more about the first moon landing and creating a newspaper article all about it.
- Year 2 This week Year 2 have been learning to measure in millilitres and litres. In science, we have also been exploring different habitats from around the world and how they change. In geography, we have been using our mapping skills.
- Year 3 In art we have been looking at one of Peter Doig's art pieces and replicating part of it. We have used string, coloured tissue paper and glue to replicate the ripples in a puddle. We have also been writing about why Hindu's and non-Hindu's visit the River Ganges in India. The children were very excited to watch a couple of volcanoes erupting in our classroom. Thank you to all parents that have helped with making these.
- Year 4 This week Year 4 have been working hard in maths where they have been learning all about the properties of different shapes and they have learnt lots of new words that they have added to their 'long word dictionaries'! In English the excitement in the class is wonderful to see as the children write character descriptions and complete designs for their own villains.
- Year 5 Year 5 have been working hard writing our letters about child labour to a variety of different prominent football figures. We will be sending them off and hoping to get some replies! We have been looking at Swallows and Amazons in guided reading and also watching parts of the original film from 1974 to help us understand the story. In maths we have been looking at decimals and solving problems relating to money and measurement.
- Year 6 Year 6 have been really busy this week rehearsing for our play. We have enjoyed moving our acting onto the stage and using some props to bring our acting to life. The next stage is for us to get into costume! We are all working hard to learn our lines so we do not need to use our scripts. In DT we have been really busy making our 'softies' for our Foundation buddies. We have created patterns, measured these out carefully and started to sew it all together. Patience and perseverance have been needed but we are doing a great job. We still need to add all the small details before they are finished. But they are already looking great! In PSHE we have been talking about the ways in which our bodies might change as we reach puberty.
