Class News

- Year F** In Foundation this week we have been marvelling at how quickly the chicks have grown! They will be going back to the farm on Thursday and we will miss their cheery cheeping and funny ways. The children have been inspired in their writing, making labels and signs, and detailed daily observations of the things they have noticed each day. This week we've also learned who the Queen is and why we are celebrating her Jubilee, learned how to sing along to 'God Save the Queen' and are excited for our Jubilee celebrations in school on Friday.
- Year 1** Year 1 had an amazing trip on Tuesday, we learnt all about seeds and how they get dispersed, helping plants to grow new plants. The children enjoyed looking around the different greenhouses and exploring the gardens. In maths we have been continuing with our times-tables and this week started to look at the ten times-table. The children have enjoyed playing our new game, fizz-buzz, showing off their times-table knowledge.
- Year 2** In Year 2, we have worked incredibly hard on our reading and maths assessments this week. Everyone has tried their best and shown great determination. In English we have been finishing the Wizard of Oz and reading a newspaper report about one of the main events from the story. We have now begun to write our own newspaper report about a different event from the story. It has been great fun interviewing each other to prepare us for this! In D&T we have been designing and making vehicles with operational wheels and axles.
- Year 3** This week in English, Year 3 have been working on our editing skills, we have been checking our newspaper reports for the key features that we know make a good report and writing a log book entry for the Lighthouse Keeper's book of events. In maths we have been continuing with fractions, we have been counting fractions on a number line and also looking at fractions of groups. We are very much looking forward to completing some art work linked to the Jubilee Day on Friday.

- Year 4** Year 4 have been really busy this week completing our learning about our play 'Bombs and Blackberries'. We have finished acting it out and have written some great new scenes using all the things we have learnt about how to structure a play script. In maths we have completed our learning on fractions and have learnt how to find fractions of amounts, including finding non-unit fractions of amounts. As artists we have worked so hard on our bas-relief sculptures of Spitfires. We have learnt how to build up different layers to create a 3-d effect, apply a thin layer of papier-mache and then paint the finished piece. We hope you enjoy seeing our finished pieces.
- Year 5** Year 5 have been working hard this week looking at fractions in maths and performing the narrative poetry that we have written. We have also continued to look at biomes in geography and we have made our kite designs in DT! We are looking forward to testing them!
- Year 6** Year 6 have been classifying animals in science. We have been working really hard bringing our Maya masks to life. We have also been looking at how to keep ourselves safe on the internet.
