Class News

- Year F In Foundation Class this week we have been helping Goldilocks to make amends to the Three Bears; we have followed a recipe to help make more porridge (and enjoyed tasting some!), used our hammering skills to fix Baby Bears chair, and designed some new duvet covers to make Baby Bears bed lovely again!
- Year 1 We enjoyed our trip to Oxford Castle on Friday last week, we enjoyed a tour of the castle and we climbed 101 steps to the top of the tower where we could see over Oxford city. We have started writing up some of the facts we learnt while we were there as part of our non-fiction unit in English. We have started work on our abstract memories in art, where we have thought about 4 memories of Year 1 and drawing and painting them to create an abstract piece of art.
- Year 2 This week Year 2 have been busy creating their own microhabitats for animals to live in. We have begun exploring fractions in maths and finding halves and in English we have been using phrases.
- Year 3 We have had a busy week preparing for our class assembly. We have started writing our adventure fantasy stories this week. We have also worked hard on our art, finishing our mixed media pictures. We cannot wait to show you! In geography we have looked at the similarities and differences between Europe and North America. We have been practising mindfulness and learning how this skill can help us when we feel wobbly.
- Year 4 This week, during science lessons, Year 4 have explored different types of habitats. Working together as a class to match animals with a suitable habitat. Discussing the key factors animals need from their environment in order to survive. The class have worked hard to finish their letters to the government, persuading the Prime Minister to do more for endangered animals. Once completed their letters will be sent to 10 Downing Street as the children are keen for their voice to be heard.
- Year 5 Year 5 have had a great week. we have continued to write our non-chronological report based on Emperor penguins. We have been exploring how we can use puns and technical language in our writing. In maths we have started looking at decimals and how these fit into our place value system. In science we have been exploring heliocentric and geocentric models of the universe.
- Year 6 Year 6 have been super busy this week as they have completed all of their SATs assessments. The class have all completed spelling, grammar, reading and maths assessments and have shown wonderful perseverance, determination and teamwork: so many of our learning powers. They have also shown great compassion towards each other and supported each other through a tricky week. Well done, Year 6 you have smashed it!
